

earned a spot in the Major League Baseball Playoffs. With a nod to British weather, the <u>Taste of Philly Picnic</u> at Historic Hope Lodge kicked off DVJC's fall event calendar. Thanks to the efforts of Tony Tinari, twenty-six members of our club inaugurated the new picnic area and enjoyed a selection

of Wawa hoagies, Tastykakes and snacks.

Although they have relinquished their Jaguar new



car franchise, <u>Land Rover</u>
<u>Allentown</u> invited DVJC
members to an open house
at their dealership. Several
of our members did attend
and enjoyed their hospitali-

ty. The dealership is continuing to support our club by advertising their service and pre-owned sales offering in the *Purr*.

Four events are scheduled during October. A <u>Century of Beautiful Automobiles</u> (previously the Classics at Brantwyn) is happening this Sunday, October 5. The Brits at the Tileworks show in Doylestown is a terrific opportunity to share our beautiful and unusual Jaguars with a large community of spectators (and, maybe, some potential members). Main Line Cars & Coffee has extended a special invitation to DVJC and non-affiliated Jaguar owners to display our cars together at the Sunday, October 26 event in Chesterbrook (Wayne), PA. In addition to the cars and coffee, DVJC will reward your participation with donuts. I hope that you are **unable** to resist the temptation and that you will join other club members that day. Finally, all club members are invited to participate in the quarterly meeting of your board of directors on Thursday October 23. In addition to normal business topics, we will be finalizing the 2026 budget and discussing an action plan to implement member survey recommendations. More information is available here.

As if struggling through the reimagination of Jaguar and several senior leadership changes over the past few years hasn't been enough, JLR was the victim of a cyber attack that began on August 31. The combined effects of the attack and proactively taking systems down to contain damage have effectively shut the company down for a month. While this shutdown has had no impact on manufacturing of Jaguars, it has completely stopped daily production of approximately one thousand Land Rovers. The shutdown has reverberated well beyond the UK facilities and through the extensive supply chain supporting its operations. An estimated thirty thousand JLR employees and over 100,000 people employed at supply chain companies have been directly impacted. As of September 29, the company is gradually restarting IT systems with the initial focus on processing payments to vendors, relaunching wholesale vehicle delivery to dealers and resuming global parts supply operations. The next step is restarting

some portions of the vehicle manufacturing process. What a nightmare! Fortunately, the past few years' financial performance has positioned the company to weather this storm.

While JLR is dealing with the fallout from the cyber-attack, we can jump in our cars, turn the key (or push the "start" button) and enjoy some

great fall driving days. Ladies and gentlemen, start your engines!




As regular readers of this column will appreciate, periodically I take the opportunity to check in on the value of vintage British metal, like that shown above. This time around, I did not have to look very far for a source of information, as the *Hagerty Insider* issue of September 17, 2025,

carried an article titled ominously "The U.K. Collector Car Market Is Still in a Crisis of Confidence". Ouch. Bad enough that the JLR mothership can't seem to buy a break these days (see "Your Monthly Bill" in this issue of the *Purr*), never mind that in the opinion of the automotive press the value of Jaguar classics even in their homeland is, shall we say, neither keeping calm nor carrying on.

In the article mentioned, John Mayhead of Hagerty presented the above graphic to illustrate some widespread malaise in the classic car market generally. He then observed specifically "... the Best of British Index, which tracks many 1950s and 1960s British cars, dropped 6%, the most of any U.K. Hagerty index. It now sits the lowest in percentage terms, the average value just over 80% of what it was in 2018." This is evident from the chart, which calls out the British index relative to other collector classes. While these are U.K. based results, I suppose that for articles of British origin the U.S. results are not appreciably different.



#### Jaguar XKE prices down over 10 years

1

Early 'flat floor' Jaguar XKE (E-Type) OTS prices are now 34 percent of what they were ten years ago (UK Hagerty Price Guide condition 2 'excellent'). Prices in GBP (£).



It gets worse. According to Mayhead and Hagerty, values of even the venerable E-Type have taken a hit: "Some models once in huge demand have continued a downward descent: The condition #2 (excellent) value of a Jaguar E-Type (XKE) SI OTS (flat floor) is £69,700, down from a peak 10 years ago of £204,000 for the same car." (At current exchange rates, that's a decrease from \$274,450 to \$93,770.) I do not necessarily believe that this level of deflation has attended the value of E-Types less rare and exotic than the fabled "flat floor" or "outside bonnet latch" examples. Nevertheless, it's a disconcert-

ing trend.





